As a church family we are involved in a wide variety of ministries and activities both in our local community and further afield. Every year we reach out and help or serve many thousands of people. We host the Ealing FoodBank, Crosslight debt advice and are involved with the Ealing Churches Winter Night Shelter. We run 'Meet & Make', 'Tinies and Tots' & 'Baby & Me' - weekly groups aimed at supporting & building community.

We also support local charities such as 'Ealing Street Pastors', Ealing Soup Kitchen & 'Besom'. Further afield we support the work of Red Tribe who work with the Massai people in Kenya, and a milk treatment project in Kigali, Rwanda. We also contribute to reaching some of the most deprived people in the world through Tearfund, and support the work of Open Doors who help persecuted Christians throughout the world.

Alongside all this, we have the day to day costs of ministry and those associated with maintaining and heating our building, which as for everyone else, have gone enormously over the past year. We also have the costs of employing staff and our 'Common Fund' contribution to the Diocese of London

The vast majority of all this is funded through the generous giving of our church family.

However, this is just a fraction of what we long to see happen! We have a vision to do so much more. The need is great and the potential enormous as we seek to reach the people of Hanwell with the good news of Jesus. Our longing is that the people of Hanwell would say that it's a better place to live and work because we are here.

So we want to keep on investing in ministry so that we play our part in seeing God's Kingdom come in Hanwell - developing new groups initiatives and activities. We also want to ensure that our church is fit for this purpose and so we are currently in the process of investing in the building by refreshing and updating it with existing plans developing for improvement.
